**CUSTOM-BUILT, MORTGAGE-FREE HOME FOR U.S. ARMY SGT. STEPHEN JACKEL
NEARING FINAL STAGES**

Home Completion Projected for Early Summer

DALLAS, Texas (April 1, 2014) –Local Dallas builder Tim Jackson Custom Homes, in partnership with Operation FINALLY HOME, The Dallas Builders Association, LP Building Products and American Country Countdown with Kix Brooks is nearing the final stages of the custom-built, mortgage-free home being built for wounded combat veteran U.S. Army Sgt. Stephen Jackel and his family.

Sgt. Jackel was injured in an IED blast in August 2011 while on a convoy mission in Afghanistan. Following the blast, Jackel saved the lives of several soldiers by helping them out of the decimated vehicle while putting out flames with his amputated leg. His injuries included bilateral below the knee amputations and a traumatic brain injury. Jackel is married to Adriana and together they have six children.

“As a company, we wanted to come together on this project and say ‘thank you’ to Stephen for all the sacrifices he’s made, especially in the past few years,” said Tim Jackson, President of Tim Jackson Custom Homes. “The home is currently in the drywall and brick laying stages with a projected home dedication date tentatively set for the end of May or early June,” said Jackson.

Operation FINALLY HOME is a 501(c)(3) organization that provides homes to wounded, ill and injured veterans and widows of the fallen. Tim Jackson Custom Homes joined forces with Operation FINALLY HOME, The Dallas Builders Association, LP Building Products and American Country Countdown with Kix Brooks to lead the project’s building efforts in October. LP Building Products has served as the lead sponsor, donating numerous materials for this build.

“Tim Jackson Custom Homes has made it a top priority to ensure this project stays on course,” said Rusty Carroll, executive director of Operation FINALLY HOME. “When we’re identifying builders for projects, attracting companies with values like theirs is what we hope for. They’ve made every effort to incorporate all the comforts that Stephen might need in his new home.”
