U.S. ARMY SGT. STEPHEN JACKEL RECEIVED KEYS TO CUSTOM-BUILT HOME AT WELCOME HOME CELEBRATION EVENT ON MAY 31

DALLAS, Texas (May 31, 2014)—Iraq and Afghanistan veteran U.S. Army Sgt. Stephen Jackel received the keys to his new custom-built home in Little Elm on Saturday. Local Dallas builder Tim Jackson Custom Homes joined forces with nonprofit Operation FINALLY HOME, the Dallas Builders Association, LP Building Products and American Country Countdown with Kix Brooks to lead the project's building efforts in October. LP Building Products has served as the lead sponsor, donating numerous materials for the build.

Operation FINALLY HOME is a 501(c)(3) organization that honors wounded, ill and injured veterans and widows of fallen soldiers with new custom-built, mortgage-free homes.

"It's not every day that we get to celebrate and give back to the soldiers who have fought to protect our freedoms," said Tim Jackson, President of Tim Jackson Custom Homes. "This build gave us a unique opportunity to come together as a community and honor Stephen for the sacrifices he made for us all."

Jackel is a highly decorated combat veteran who has been deployed to both Iraq and Afghanistan. Jackel was injured in an Improved Explosive Device (IED) blast in August 2011 while on a convoy mission in Afghanistan. Following the blast, Jackel saved the lives of several soldiers by helping them out of the decimated vehicle while putting out flames with his leg. His injuries included bilateral below the knee amoutations and a traumatic brain injury. Jackel and his wife, Adriana, have six children.

In addition to the support received from Tim Jackson Custom Homes, the Dallas Builders Association also played a pivotal role in the Jackel project.

"It was an honor to join Operation FINALLY HOME in their efforts to give back to our nation's veterans," said Phil Crone, executive officer of the Dallas Builders Association. "When we were approached to help with this project, I knew it would be hard work, but I also knew that it would be an extremely rewarding experience with an impact that would last far longer than an average build."

"The Jackel home gave us the chance to work with some great organizations," said Rusty Carroll, executive director of Operation FINALLY HOME. "We could not be more grateful for the help and generosity of everyone who has been involved with this project, especially Tim and his team."
